Jurisdiction – held under the National Sporting Code of the Auto Cycle Union. The standing regs for this event and these supplementary regulations.

Limit of Entry – First 200 Solos, Quads & Sidecars received in the post or on-line (if available) **with full payment**

Classes – Junior A, Junior B, Novice, Evolution, Twinshock, Over 35's, Youth up to 85cc 2 Stroke or upto 150cc 4 stroke only (9-14yrs), Youth Open (14-16yrs), Quads & Sidecars

Entries – to be made on the correct entry form for the event and to be received by the entries secretary no later than 6th February 2012. Cornwall Motor Cross Club membership £5.00 per annum – Also, if day licence required please pay with entry at £10 per entrant.

Please check club website or telephone the Entry Secretary for numbers and final Instructions after 9th February

Entry Fees – Solos £35, Quads & Sidecars £35 – Youth £20. Cheques, in all instances, payable to "Cornwall Motor Cross Club Ltd". Entrants (excluding Sidecar Passengers) will be charged £10 per additional class entered

Subject to class size late entries maybe accepted at club discretion but will be subject to an additional £10 late entry fee
Club Membership & ACU Licences will be inspected on the day

Machines – The Motor Cycles used in this event must comply with the specifications laid down for this type of event. Any tyre choice can be used, no more than 96DbA (Noise test will be present)

Clothing – As per National Sporting Code - Leather knee length boots, Gloves & Helmet (with minimum ACU silver standard)

Course – Sloping field with no jumps.

Technical Inspection – Strictly 8.00am – 9.00am only Start Times – Practice 9.30am, First Race 10.15am

Awards – This event will form part of the Cornwall Motor Cross Club Championship which will be open to fully paid members of the Club only.

Abandonment – The organisers reserve the right to alter, change or cancel any class or the event in total if circumstances demand it

Non Starters – As per Cornwall Centre rules all entrants who do not take part must send a satisfactory reason for their absence to the Secretary of the Meeting within 7 days of the event (Verbal excuses not accepted)
